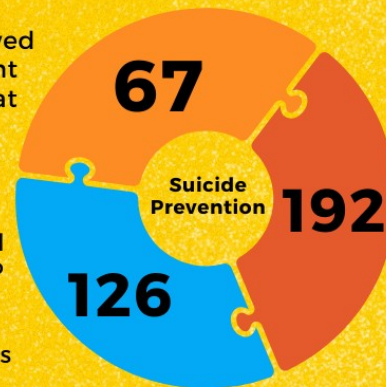

Leaders in Suicide Prevention

Veterans today are 6x more likely to die by suicide than in combat. There is no single cause of suicide, and therefore prevention requires a coordinated health approach addressing the whole self. In 2024, our Easterseals was awarded a \$538K Federal Staff Sergeant Fox Suicide Prevention Grant to expand Mental and Behavioral Health services for Service Members, Veterans and their Families (SMVFs).

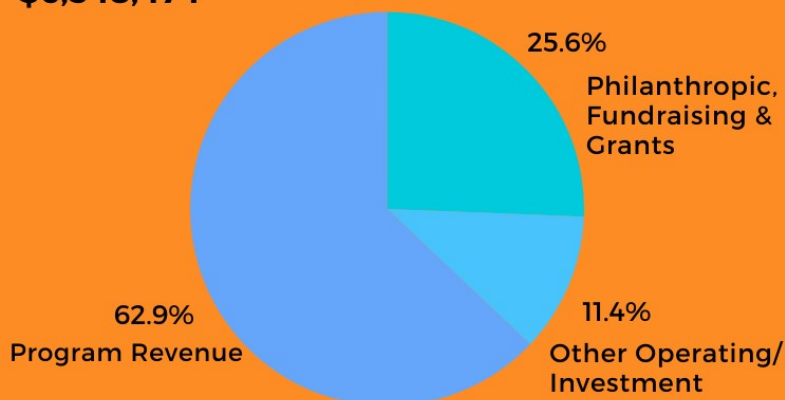
